HARVEST TIME — REAPING WHAT GOD HAS GROWN

“Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.” Galatians 6:9

WEEK 1 — SEEDS OF FAITH

Thursday, October 1 — Day 1: Plant the Seed

Mark 4:26–27

Prayer: Lord, help me faithfully plant the seeds You have placed in my hands.

Prayer Point: Pray for faithfulness in the small things God has given you to do.

Friday, October 2 — Day 2: Good Ground

Luke 8:15

Prayer: Lord, prepare my heart to receive and obey Your Word.

Prayer Point: Pray for a heart that is receptive to God's truth.

Saturday, October 3 — Day 3: Sow Generously

2 Corinthians 9:6

Prayer: Give me a generous heart that freely gives to others.

Prayer Point: Pray for opportunities to sow your time, gifts, encouragement, and resources.

Sunday, October 4 — Day 4: Seeds of Righteousness

Hosea 10:12

Prayer: Help me sow what is right and pleasing in Your sight.

Prayer Point: Pray that your daily choices produce godly fruit.

Monday, October 5 — Day 5: Water the Seed

1 Corinthians 3:6–7

Prayer: Lord, remind me that You are the One who brings the increase.

Prayer Point: Pray for patience when you cannot yet see the results.

Tuesday, October 6 — Day 6: Don't Dig It Up

Hebrews 10:36

Prayer: Give me endurance while I wait for Your promises.

Prayer Point: Pray against impatience, doubt, and giving up too soon.

Wednesday, October 7 — Day 7: Trust the Growth

Mark 4:28

Prayer: Help me trust what You are developing, even when I cannot see it.

Prayer Point: Pray for confidence in God's unseen work.

WEEK 2 — GROWING THROUGH THE PROCESS

Thursday, October 8 — Day 8: Growing Strong

Job 8:7

Prayer: Lord, strengthen me as I continue growing.

Prayer Point: Pray for steady spiritual growth.

Friday, October 9 — Day 9: Don't Despise Small Beginnings

Zechariah 4:10

Prayer: Help me appreciate every small beginning.

Prayer Point: Pray for patience with the beginning stages of your dreams, ministry, family, or personal growth.

Saturday, October 10 — Day 10: Growing Through Trials
Romans 5:3–4 Prayer: Use even my difficult seasons to develop my character. Prayer Point: Pray that trials produce perseverance rather than bitterness.
Sunday, October 11 — Day 11: Deeply Planted
Jeremiah 17:7–8 Prayer: Keep me planted and trusting in You. Prayer Point: Pray for strong spiritual roots during uncertain seasons.
Monday, October 12 — Day 12: God Gives the Increase
1 Corinthians 3:7 Prayer: Keep me humble as You bring growth into my life. Prayer Point: Pray that God receives the glory for every accomplishment.
Tuesday, October 13 — Day 13: Growing in Wisdom
Proverbs 2:6 Prayer: Give me wisdom for this season of my life. Prayer Point: Pray for godly wisdom before making important decisions.
Wednesday, October 14 — Day 14: Mature Faith
James 1:4 Prayer: Continue developing maturity and completeness in me. Prayer Point: Pray for spiritual maturity and endurance.
WEEK 3 — DON'T GROW WEARY
Thursday, October 15 — Day 15: Keep Doing Good
Galatians 6:9 Prayer: Give me strength to keep going when I become tired. Prayer Point: Pray for those who are weary from serving, caregiving, working, or waiting.
Friday, October 16 — Day 16: Strength for the Work
Nehemiah 6:9 Prayer: Lord, strengthen my hands for the work before me. Prayer Point: Pray for renewed strength to complete your assignments.
Saturday, October 17 — Day 17: Keep Sowing
Ecclesiastes 11:6 Prayer: Help me remain faithful even when results are uncertain. Prayer Point: Pray for consistency and discipline.
Sunday, October 18 — Day 18: Wait for It
Habakkuk 2:3 Prayer: Teach me to trust Your appointed time. Prayer Point: Pray for patience concerning something you have been waiting for.
Monday, October 19 — Day 19: Strengthened Hands
Isaiah 35:3–4 Prayer: Strengthen the weak places in me and remove fear. Prayer Point: Pray for someone who feels discouraged or ready to quit.
Tuesday, October 20 — Day 20: Faithful Until Harvest
James 5:7 Prayer: Give me the patience of a farmer who waits expectantly for the harvest. Prayer Point: Pray for patience without losing expectation.

Wednesday, October 21 — Day 21: God Remembers
Hebrews 6:10 Prayer: Thank You that my labor of love is not forgotten by You. Prayer Point: Pray for those who serve faithfully but feel unseen.

Thursday, October 22 — Day 22: Fruit That Honors God
Philippians 1:11 Prayer: Let my life produce fruit that brings You glory. Prayer Point: Pray that your character reflects Christ.
Friday, October 23 — Day 23: A Harvest of Peace
James 3:18 Prayer: Make me a peacemaker wherever You place me. Prayer Point: Pray for peace in homes, churches, workplaces, and relationships.
Saturday, October 24 — Day 24: Fruitful Words
Proverbs 12:14 Prayer: Let my words produce encouragement and life. Prayer Point: Pray for wisdom concerning what you say and how you say it.
Sunday, October 25 — Day 25: Fruitful Work
Psalms 90:17 Prayer: Establish the work of my hands for Your glory. Prayer Point: Pray over your work, ministry, business, family, and assignments.
Monday, October 26 — Day 26: Fruit of Generosity
Proverbs 11:25 Prayer: Make me generous with what You have entrusted to me. Prayer Point: Ask God to show you someone you can bless.
Tuesday, October 27 — Day 27: Fruit That Remains
John 15:16 Prayer: Let what I do for You have lasting impact. Prayer Point: Pray that your influence leaves a godly legacy.
Wednesday, October 28 — Day 28: A Harvest of Righteousness
Philippians 1:9–11 Prayer: Grow righteousness, love, and discernment in me. Prayer Point: Pray for your life to increasingly resemble Christ.
WEEK 5 — GATHER & GIVE THANKS
Thursday, October 29 — Day 29: Look at the Fields
John 4:35 Prayer: Open my eyes to the people and opportunities around me. Prayer Point: Pray for opportunities to share God's love and encourage someone.
Friday, October 30 — Day 30: The Harvest Is Great
Luke 10:2 Prayer: Lord, send workers into Your harvest and use me wherever You desire. Prayer Point: Pray for churches, ministries, missionaries, leaders, and believers serving their communities.
Saturday, October 31 — Day 31: Celebrate the Harvest
Psalms 126:5–6 Prayer: Thank You for every seed, every lesson, every season of growth, and every harvest You have brought into my life. Prayer Point: Spend time thanking God for answered prayers, spiritual growth, restored relationships, new opportunities, and victories—both seen and unseen.
